



- Installed a new 12-inch water main to serve the Fresh Mark food production facility when the 60-year-old 10-inch main was nearing the end of its useful life.
- Replaced the 1,900 linear feet of main serving the business as part of a \$4.4 million dollar 2017 infrastructure investment plan.
- Replaced more than 22,000 linear feet of main in the Stark County system serving 36,000 customers over the 2017 construction.
- Invested more than \$11.7 million in the Stark County system between 2015 and 2017 alone.
